ROLE:

This entry-level position will report to the EddyWatch & SurveyWatch Program Manager.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Metocean Analyst will have the following duties and responsibilities:

- Assessment, compilation, and analysis of oceanographic data to provide daily nowcast, forecast and advisory reports on ocean current conditions.
- Identifying and uploading data sources, data QA/QC, data analysis and presentation, and the preparation of reports for site-specific metocean studies.
- Utilizing and developing mathematical and scientific techniques to compile, analyze, interpret, and graphically depict metocean data.
- Review, analysis, and synthesis of scientific literature.
- Correspondence with clients and vendors in support of operations
- Presentation of information in client meetings, professional scientific/industry conferences and in scientific/industry publications.

KEY QUALIFICATIONS AND CAPABILITIES:

Marine Science graduate with a strong interest in metocean data analysis and interpretation. The applicant should have educational experience with metocean data analysis, including:

- BS degree in physical oceanography, meteorology, physical or marine science required, MS degree preferred.
- High level programming, mathematical, and problem-solving skills.
- Proficiency in MATLAB and Python.
- Familiarity with other programming languages, such as R, C#, C++, HTML, Java etc.
- Experience with numerical forecast models is a plus.
